

Copyright fees

If our images are to be used in any publication, whether in print, electronic or other format, permission must be first obtained from the Mills Archive. A copyright acknowledgment will be required whenever the image is reproduced.

If publication is envisaged or subsequently an image is published, a copyright fee will be charged. The copyright fee may be waived or reduced at the discretion of the Trustees and details are available of the categories of use and user which would qualify.

Private individuals

No copyright fee will be charged to individuals if, at the time of order, the purchaser declares that the images are for research and private study only and will not be passed to others. Otherwise the copyright fee for private individuals is £50.00 for each image. Fees will be waived or reduced for Friends of the Mills Archive.

Commercial rates

A world-wide copyright licence for a single image in a single publication costs £750; the corresponding UK only licence fee is £400. These fees are reduced by 50% for organisations who have been Corporate Friends for more than two years. Orders for multiple images placed at the same time attract a 50% discount on the second and subsequent images.

Academic and special interest publications

Subject to approval by our Trustees, copyright fees may be waived or reduced for academic or mill-related printed publications. Use by special interest groups whether in print or on the Internet is possible by agreement and following a £25 donation.

Note

These fees and arrangements only apply to images where we hold the copyright or we have an arrangement with the copyright holder.

Fees are in addition to any charges applicable to the download of high-resolution images.

Copyright licences are only valid from the date payment is cleared in our bank.
